




# **1. SIX DEGREES.**


## 2. Dispatches from the Front Lines of Climate Justice.


### 3. Drawdown: A Plan to Reverse Global Warming.

This is one of the best books on global warming that discusses a tangible plan to mitigate climate change.




## 4. Unprecedented Climate Mobilization.

This global warming book argues that despite the urgency and existential threat of climate change, governments haven't yet stepped up to act.




## 5. The Wizard and the Prophet.

In this global warming book, you will explore four great challenges humanity faces, food, water, energy and climate change.




## 6. The Parents' Guide to Climate Revolution.


## 7. The Water Will Come.
